- Day 3 comprises a review lesson, focusing on the content from lessons 1 and 2, and the first Reading practice session. We recommend two shorter sessions on this day as shown in the grid.
- Quick review: The grids show the focus GPCs and words to be reviewed. However, you should continue reviewing all GPCs that the children have been taught until they are secure.
- Tricky words: The 'tricky' part of the word is shown in bold. Where there are two tricky parts, one part is in red. Words in [red and brackets] are tricky words that are now decodable.
- *This GPC has a slight schwa at the end 'chuh'.
- **In some accents, this GPC will be pronounced /a/ so it need not be taught in Phase 5.
- Sentences for reading/writing are included in the Rapid Catch-up area of the website.
